Further promoting our advocacy, awareness, positive parenting, anti-bullying, and social media campaigns, to help advocate for American children and raise public awareness of the epidemic of child abuse and bullying in America, and to help end child abuse in all forms. Our blogs will also encourage our community of supporters, to get involved and join us as we give a voice to the 'voiceless' — the abused, neglected, bullied, and marginalized children of America.

- Help write or source articles for our weekly blog, monthly e-newsletter, and special events.
- Ensure articles are free of grammatical and spelling errors.
- Help source royalty-free images.
- Review copyright restrictions.
