Description

The Newsletter Contributor is an unpaid virtual volunteer position. He/she will assist with creating the monthly and special event e-newsletters, and will report to our Newsletter Editor. The newsletter requires engaging and topical written content, sharing American SPCC's vision, mission, initiatives and events in a beautiful and visual manner. Monthly news and activities will be summarized to keep supporters, donors, volunteers, and the public abreast of American SPCC campaigns, progress, projects and accomplishments, linking back to our website.

This role directly contributes to American SPCC's vision and mission to promote social impact to end abuse and improve children's lives, via the organization's advocacy, awareness, and education initiatives. Predetermined issues promoted by American SPCC include, but are not limited to: child abuse, child neglect, child sexual abuse, child exploitation, trafficking, bullying, cyberbullying, domestic violence, foster care, child safety, shaken baby syndrome and positive parenting.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Research current events, developments, and articles focused on our monthly themes, and topics, as listed above.
- Write & source articles for the monthly e-newsletter based on predetermined topics.
- Summarize and focus on the organization's monthly milestones, news and activities.
- Ensure articles are free of grammatical and spelling errors.
- Review and confirm copyright approval or restrictions.

Skills & Personal Traits

- Excellent verbal/written communication, creative writing, grammar and proofreading skills,
- Demonstrates creative copy writing and copy-editing skills.
- Marketing, communications and SEO skills, a plus.
- Interest in nonprofit sector and ability to maintain the "voice" of an organization.
- Interest in writing, advocating for children and raising awareness of child abuse and bullying.
- Works well independently and proactively as part of a team.
- Ability to adhere to deadlines.

Qualifications/Requirements

- Journalism or communication education.
- Practical experience in creative article writing.
- Micro influencer and large social media network is an asset.

Term/Commitment

This position requires a minimum 3-month commitment for an average of 2-4 hours per week, which will be completed virtually in the Newsletter Contributor's own office or home. Position commitment is subject to renew and extension by agreement from both parties.
